

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE BY-LAW NUMBER 90-2005

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 88-98, BEING BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A 40 KILOMETRES PER HOUR MAXIMUM RATE OF SPEED ON SPECIFIED ROADS AND TO AMEND BY-LAW 78-2005, BEING THE TRAFFIC BY-LAW. (Oak Ridge Drive)

WHEREAS The Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, Section 128 (2), authorizes the council of a municipality to prescribe by by-law a rate of speed different from the rate set out in subsection (1) of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville deems it expedient to establish speed limits on specified roads;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the municipal council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

- 1. THAT Schedule "A" to By-law 88-98, establishing a 40 kilometre per hour speed limit on specified roads, be further amended to add:
 - Oak Ridge Drive from 75 metres north of Highway 9 to the south limits of 86 Oak Ridge Drive and the north limits of 91 Oak Ridge Drive
- 2. THAT Schedule "H" to By-law 78-2005, setting out a maximum rate of speed on specified highways, be amended to add:
 - Oak Ridge Drive from 75 metres north of Highway 9 to the south limits of 86
 Oak Ridge Drive and the north limits of 91 Oak Ridge Drive
