# A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 78-2005 WITH RESPECT TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS (Palace Court, York Street, 114 Broadway laneway)

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.11 authorizes a municipality to pass bylaws respecting matters within the jurisdiction of highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 78-2005, as amended.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the municipal council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

1. THAT Schedule "A" (parking restrictions) of By-law 78-2005, be amended by adding the following:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	Restrictions
Palace Court	West	For a distance of 80 metres beginning at the southerly curb on Spencer Avenue and measuring along the curb	Any time.
York Street	North	Bythia Street and 55 metres (180 feet) easterly	Any time.
Laneway abutting 114 Broadway	Both	South Broadway property line and 19 metres southerly	Any time, except for a 20 minute period for loading and off-loading.
