BY-LAW NUMBER 8 -80.

A BY-LAW TO LICENSE, REGULATE AND GOVERN KEEPERS OF STORES AND SHOPS WHERE TOBACCO, CIGARS OR CIGARETTES ARE SOLD BY RETAIL AND FOR REVOKING ANY SUCH LICENSES.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to license, regulate and govern keepers of stores and shops where tobacco, cigars or cigarettes are sold in the Town of Orangeville.

THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall sell or offer for sale tobacco, cigars or cigarettes in the Town of Orangeville without first having obtained a license therefor.
- 2. All persons desirous of obtaining such license shall make application in writing to the Clerk of the Municipal Council of the Town of Orangeville.
- 3. A fee of \$20.00 shall be paid for each license.

- 4. The said license shall terminate on the 31st day of December in the year in which it was issued and no license shall be transferable except by resolution of Council.
- 5. Every person issued a license under this By-Law shall prominently display the Micense at the place of business for which it was issued.

If at any time during the term of any license, the holder of the license is in breach of this by-law or any other law or if Council is of the opinion that the continued use of such license by the license holder may result in a breach of the law or may in any way be adverse to the public interest Council may revoke such license.

- (2) Before revoking any license, the holder thereof shall be given at least 7 days notice mailed by prepaid registered mail to the address recorded on the license or delivered to a person apparently of the age of majority at the address shown on the license and the license holder shall be permitted either by himself or by his solicitor or agent to appear before Council to show cause why such license should not be revoked.
- 7. Every person who contravenes any provisions of this by-law shall upon conviction be liable to a penalty of not more than \$1,000.00 exclusive of costs for each offence which penalty is recoverable under The Summary Convictions Act.
- 8. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect from the first day of January, 1980.
- 9. By-Laws 1648, 1665, 1872 are hereby repealed. PASSED IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 4th DAY OF FEBRUARY, A.D., 1980.
