# A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 78-2005 WITH RESPECT TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON FOURTH AVENUE

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.11* authorizes a municipality to pass bylaws respecting matters within the jurisdiction of highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS on November 24, 2008, Council passed a motion that had the effect of restricting parking on both sides of Fourth Avenue between First Street and Highway 10;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the municipal council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

1. THAT Schedule "A" (parking restrictions) of By-law 78-2005, be amended by **deleting** the following:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	Between	Restrictions
Fourth Avenue	North	Second Street and Third Street	Any time
Fourth Avenue	South	First Street and Third Street	Any time
Fourth Avenue	Both	Third Street and King's Highway # 10	Any time

2. THAT Schedule "A" (parking restrictions) of By-law 78-2005, be amended by adding the following:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	Restrictions
Fourth Avenue	Both	First Street and King's Highway # 10	Any time
