TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE

BY-LAW NUMBER 103-96

Being a by-law to amend By-law Number 22-90, as amended, to permit bed and breakfast establishments as home occupations.

WHEREAS THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE DEEMS IT APPROPRIATE TO ENACT THIS BY-LAW;

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the following section is hereby added to By-law 22-90, as amended:
 - "2.11A Bed and breakfast establishment means a portion of a dwelling used for the accommodation of the travelling public and for the provision of meals to overnight guests only, and shall not include a hotel, motel, tourist home, boarding house, group home, crisis care centre or restaurant."
- 2. THAT Section 2.53 of By-law 22-90, as amended, is hereby amended to add the following:
 - " a bed and breakfast establishment"
- 3. THAT Section 5.12(d) of By-law 22-90, as amended, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence thereto:
 - "Notwithstanding the foregoing, a bed and breakfast establishment may exceed the foregoing floor area limitations but the number of guest bedrooms shall not exceed three."
- 4. THAT Section 5.15 of By-law 22-90, as amended, is hereby amended to add the following words after "Home Occupation" in the table in subsection (1)(a) thereof:
 - "(other than a bed and breakfast establishment)"
- 5. THAT Section 5.15 of By-law 22-90, as amended, is hereby amended to add the following in the table in subsection (1)(a) thereof:

"Bed and Breakfast Establishment

one parking space for each guest bedroom."
