



## The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville

### By-law Number 2026-006

#### **A by-law to amend by-law 2025-065 to add stop controls and amend Schedule a of current Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2025-065**

Whereas Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (the "Municipal Act, 2001") provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person; and

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Whereas subsection 10(2) paragraph 7 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended provides that a municipal may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public; and

Whereas subsection 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law; and

Whereas Sections 11(2) & (3) of the Municipal Act, 2001 permits a municipality to pass by- laws respecting the matters dealing with its public assets and highways; and

Whereas Section 44(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that a municipality that has jurisdiction over a highway or **bridge** shall keep it in a state of repair that is reasonable in the circumstances, including the character and location of the highway or **bridge**;

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council for The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule E and Schedule F of Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2025-065 be deleted and replaced with the schedules attached.


This by-law shall come into effect upon approval by the Council, subject to section 284.11 of the Municipal Act.
