



## **The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville**

### **By-law Number 2026-023**

#### **A by-law to amend Traffic Management Bylaw 2025-065 by deleting Schedule "R" respecting short form wording and set fines.**

Whereas Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass bylaws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways under their jurisdiction; and

Whereas Section 102 of the Municipal Act, 2001 authorizes a municipality to require the payment of fees and charges for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; and

Whereas Section 151 and 151.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001 authorizes a municipality to establish a system of administrative penalties and to require a person to pay an administrative penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person has failed to comply with a bylaw respecting the parking, standing or stopping of vehicles; and

Whereas Ontario Regulation 333/07 (Administrative Penalties) made under the Municipal Act, 2001 sets out requirements and procedures for administrative penalty systems related to parking, standing and stopping violations; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville has enacted an Administrative Penalty System Bylaw to establish a system of administrative penalties, including Schedule "A" which sets out the applicable short form wording and administrative penalty amounts for designated offences; and

Whereas the Town's Traffic Management Bylaw currently includes a schedule prescribing short-form wording and set fines for parking-related offences; and

Whereas Council deems it appropriate and desirable to amend the Traffic Management and Parking Bylaw to remove the schedule prescribing short form wording and set fines, and instead reference Schedule "A" of the Administrative Penalty System Bylaw for the purpose of consistency.

Now therefore, be it resolved that Council for the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Traffic Management and Parking Bylaw 2025-065 is hereby amended.
2. That Schedule "R" to Traffic Management and Parking Bylaw 2025-065, being the schedule prescribing short form wording and set fines for parking offences, is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:  

"Penalties referred in Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049."
3. This by-law shall come into effect upon approval by the Council, subject to section 284.11 of the Municipal Act.

Read three times and finally passed this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2026.
