BY-LAW NUMBER. 7-81....

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF CERTAIN VEHICLES AND CONVEYANCES IN A PARK, PARK-LOT, GARDEN OR OTHER PLACE SET APART FOR ORNAMENT OR EMBELLISHMENT OR FOR PUBLIC RECREATION AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW NUMBER 8-76

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. Vehicles and conveyances of every description and motive power except wheel chairs, baby carriages and children's wagons, kiddle cars, tricycles and sleighs are prohibited from being in or upon any park, park-lot, garden or other place set apart for ornament or embellishment or for public recreation.
- Section 1 shall not apply to vehicles and conveyances
  - (1) of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville or its agents or servants when engaged in carrying out the performance of their duties.
  - (2) present at a public function which has been authorized by Resolution of the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville, or
  - (3) parked in an area where properly worded signs have been erected and are on display permitting parking.
- 3. (1) Where a vehicle or conveyance is parked in or upon a park, park-lot, garden or other place set apart for ornament or embellishment or for public recreation in contravention of Section 1, any police officer or by-law enforcement officer so finding it may attach to it a parking ticket

in the form of a serially numbered notice stating.

- (a) a concise description of the vehicle or conveyance and the permit number if a permit number is attached to it,
- (b) the vehicle or conveyance is unlawfully parked upon the park, park-lot, garden or other place set apart for ornament or embellishment or for public recreation,
- (c) the date, time and place of the alleged offence,
- (d) that the driver, operator or owner thereof may report to the office of the Clerk of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville within 2 days, exclusive of Sundays and holidays, after the day when the ticket is attached, to make a voluntary payment of the penalty, and
- (e) that in event of failure to so report and make such payment a summons will be issued under The Provincial Offences Act, 1979.
- The parking ticket shall be prepared in triplicate and the police officer or by-law enforcement officer shall attach one copy to the vehicle or conveyance and deliver the other copies to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville.
- (3) If payment in the sum of \$5.00 is made within 2 days, exclusive of Sundays and holidays, after the day when the ticket is attached to the vehicle or conveyance, to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville or any person designated by him to receive such payment, such payment shall be accepted as payment of the penalty in full satisfaction in respect of the alleged offence

and receipt therefor shall be given to the person making the payment.

- (4) If the payment is not voluntarily made in accordance with the procedure provided in this section, the procedure of The Provincial Offences Act, 1979 and the penalties provided in this by-law shall apply.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 exclusive of costs which shall be recoverable under The Provincial Offences Act, 1979.
- 5. By-law Number 8-76 is repealed.
