By-law Number 67-2013

A by-law to amend Retail Business Holiday Exemption By-law 25-2011 to permit all businesses to be open on certain holidays

Whereas By-law 25-2011 permits retail business establishments in the Town of Orangeville with a total retail area of 2,400 square feet or more and/or four or more employees serving the public to be open on certain holidays for the maintenance or development of tourism;

And whereas the size restriction excludes smaller businesses that are not exempt under the *Retail Business Holidays Act* from opening on the holidays;

Be it therefore enacted by the municipal council of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

1. That By-law 25-2011 be amended to delete Section 1.2, as follows:

"That the holiday opening exemptions provided under Section 1.1 above shall apply to any retail establishments in the Town of Orangeville with a total retail area of 2,400 square feet or more and/or four or more employees serving the public.
