By-law Number 078-2016

A by-law to authorize an agreement with Powell Contracting Limited (Removal and Replacement of Noise Attenuation Fence)

Whereas the the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.9 provides a municipality with the powers of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

And whereas Council deems it expedient to enter into an agreement to tender terms and conditions for Tender No. 11PW-16 with Powell Contracting Limited for the removal and replacement of noise attenuation fences;

Be it therefore enacted by the municipal council of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

- 1. That the agreement to tender terms and conditions for Tender No. 11PW-16 between Powell Contracting Limited and The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville with respect to the removal and replacement of noise attenuation fences, in the same form as the agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A", is hereby approved.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the said agreement and any other documents required to finalize the transaction on behalf of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville and to affix the corporate seal thereto.

Agreement to Tender Terms and Conditions for

Tender No. 11PW-16

Between

The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville

(hereinafter called the Town)

and

Powell Contracting Limited

(hereinafter called the Contractor)

Whereas the Town has issued Tender No. 11PW-16 for Removal and Replacement of Noise Attenuation Fence which closed on July 11, 2016 and is attached hereto as Schedule "A";

And Whereas at its meeting of July 18, 2016, the Council of the Town passed a motion accepting the tender of the Contractor in accordance with its requirements of Tender No. 11PW-16;

Now Therefore the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Town and the Contractor agree that the terms and conditions contained in the Tender attached hereto as Schedule "A" (the Tender), form part of this Agreement and are binding upon the parties, except as modified by this Agreement.
- 2. In the event of any discrepancy between the Tender and this Agreement, then this Agreement shall prevail.
- 3. The Contractor, and all employees, agents, contractors, or persons for whom it is responsible at law, shall comply with all applicable municipal, provincial and federal laws, regulations, by-laws and policies, and all policies and procedures of the Town.
- 4. In the event of any legislative or regulatory amendment that comes into effect during the term of this Agreement which materially affects its terms and conditions of this Agreement, the parties shall negotiate in good faith any new term that may be necessary and enter into a written amending agreement that shall be attached hereto.

Should the parties fail to reach an agreement on the revision of the terms of this Agreement as a result of a legislative or regulatory amendment, as may be necessary, the parties hereby agree to arbitration pursuant to the Arbitration Act (Ontario).

- 5. This Agreement, or any work required under this Agreement, shall not be assigned, transferred or sub-contracted by the Contractor, in whole or in part, without the written consent of the Town, provided that any consent to assign shall not relieve the Contractor from its obligations pursuant to this Agreement, or the liability to the Contractor therefrom.
- 6. The Contractor shall bear the risk and responsibility of any loss, damage or expense to the work or to itself of any nature and kind whatsoever, arising from strikes or labour disputes.
- 7. The Town's conduct, silence or inaction in enforcing an obligation of the Contractor, or exercising any of the Town's rights or remedies, does not amount to a waiver of that obligation, right or remedy.
- 8. This Agreement shall enure and be binding on the parties, and their respective successors and assigns.
- 9. Any notice required or permitted to be provided under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be given by personal delivery or by registered mail postage prepaid and addressed to the intended recipient as follows, or to such other addresses as may be provided by notice:

If any notice is sent by registered mail, postage prepaid, it shall be deemed to be received by the party to whom it was mailed on the fifth day following the day in which it was deposited into the federal post service unless the fifth day is a Saturday, Sunday or statutory holiday, in which case it shall be deemed to have been received on the following day not being a Saturday, Sunday or statutory holiday; if given by personal delivery, receipt of the notice shall be deemed to have been given on the day of actual delivery thereof.

10. Time shall be of the essence in this Agreement.

- 11. This Agreement shall be construed by, and governed in accordance with, the laws of the Province of Ontario.
- 12. In the event that any provision hereof may be void or unenforceable for any reason, such provision or provisions shall be considered severable from the remaining provisions, which shall continue in full force and effect.
- 13. In this Agreement, words imparting the singular number include the plural and vice versa and words imparting the masculine gender include the feminine and neuter genders.
- 14. This Agreement, and its schedules, shall constitute the entire Agreement between the parties hereto. There is no representation, warranty, collateral agreement or condition affecting this Agreement other than as expressed here in writing.
