# A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 78-2005 WITH RESPECT TO SET FINE RATES.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.11* authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws respecting matters within the jurisdiction of highways, including parking and traffic on highways;
