## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE

BY-LAW NO .//-67.

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE OBSTRUCTING, ENCUMBERING, INJURING OR FOULING OF HIGHWAYS OR BRIDGES

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- (1) The obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways or bridges under the jurisdiction of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville is hereby prohibited.
- Every person who contravenes this By-law is guilty of an offence punishable by the imposition of a fine not exceeding \$300.00, exclusive of costs, and such fine and costs shall be recoverable under the provisions of The Summary Convictions Act provided that in the event of non-payment of the said fine and costs, the offender shall be liable to a term of imprisonment for a period not exceeding 21 days.

This By-law shall come into force and take effect from and after the passing thereof.
