BY-LAW NUMBER 82-2012

A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 78-2005 TO SUSPEND PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON A TEMPORARY BASIS. (Elizabeth Street and McCarthy Street)

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.11* authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws respecting matters within the jurisdiction of highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 78-2005, as amended, to temporarily suspend the parking prohibition on a section of the north side of Elizabeth Street and a section on the north side of McCarthy Street to facilitate the construction of the property at 1 Elizabeth Street;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the municipal council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

- 1. THAT Schedule "A" (no parking where signs are posted) of By-law 78-2005 be amended to suspend parking prohibitions on the following sections of streets:
 - North side of Elizabeth Street from 10 metres west of the entrance into the Lord Dufferin Centre to Faulkner Street, between 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.
 - North side of McCarthy Street from 10 metres west of the lane running northerly of McCarthy Street and west of First Street to Faulkner Street.
- 2. THAT this by-law be in effect from September 25, 2012 up to and including January 24, 2013.
