BY-LAW NUMBER 56-99

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT LITTERING ON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M. 45, as amended, provides that municipalities may pass by-laws prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality or any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

- No person shall throw, place or deposit any refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality or any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property.
- 2. Any person who contravenes paragraph 1 of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty as provided for under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O., 1990 Chapter P.33 as amended.
- 3. By-law Number 30-78 is hereby repealed.
- 4. This by-law shall be known as the "Littering Bylaw".
