By-law Number 2026-055

A by-law to amend by-law 2025-050, being a by-law to establish the positions of Screening and Hearing Officers for the purpose of administration of an Administrative Penalty System within the Town of Orangeville

Whereas the Town established the position of screening officer and hearing officer through Bylaw 2025-050, which are required for the operation of the Town's Administrative Penalty By-law; and

Whereas the Appointment of Screening Officers and Hearing Officers policy approved by Council on August 11, 2025 through resolution number 2025-151 indicates through s. 5.1 that an Issuing Officer is ineligible to be a Screening Officer and that Town employees are eligible;

Now therefore be it resolved that Council for The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enacts as follows:

1. That section 5.1 a) of Bylaw 2025-050 be deleted and replaced with the following:

a) an Issuing Officer;

This bylaw shall come into effect upon approval by the Council, subject to section 284.11 of the Municipal Act.
