## By-law Number 2023-038

## A by-law to amend By-law 2003-041 as amended, to permit Boulevard Cafes in the Central Business District

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville has passed By-law Number 2003-041 to permit the seasonal establishment of boulevard café's in the Central Business District.

And whereas Council wishes to support area business activity while ensuring safe and accessible pedestrian mobility.

And whereas Council at its meeting held on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2023, passed Resolution number 2023-008 to extend the length of time that boulevard café's are permitted in a calendar year and provide more flexibility for boulevard café configurations.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council for The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Section 1 (Definitions) of By-law 2003-041, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending the definitions of "boulevard café" and "summer season" as follows:

1.1 "**boulevard café**" means a designated outdoor area on the sidewalk associated with an adjoining commercial premises where food and drink are offered for sale, no wider than the width of the premises' storefront, excluding the width of the entrance and may include up to two (2) parking spaces in front of the subject commercial premises.

1.5 "**summer season**" means the period between April 1 and October 31 of any given year.

2. That Section 6 (General Conditions) of By-law 2003-041 as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting Section 6.12 and replacing with the following:

- 6.12 That a boulevard café permit shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:
- (a) all Public Health and Safety guidelines be complied with;
- (b) that all outdoor patio furniture, equipment and other items be removed as required by the Town for snow removal or property maintenance;
- (c) any safety measures applied by the Town as part of the approval of an permit be adhered to.
- 3. That Section 6 (General Conditions) of By-law 2003-041 as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following:
  - 6.13 The number of on-street parking spaces cumulatively occupied by all boulevard cafés within the Central Business District shall not exceed a total of six (6) spaces. Permits for boulevard cafés that occupy parking space(s) may be issued on a first come, first serve basis until this cumulative maximum is reached.
  - 6.14 No part of a boulevard café or its enclosing features (such as a fence or railing) may encroach within 0.5 metres from the street-side face of the curb, or any such greater distance as the Town may require.
