



The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville

By-law Number 2026-025

A by-law to amend the Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049 to add Schedules "B-17" and "B-18" respecting administrative penalties for the Election Sign Bylaw and Salvage Yard Bylaw.

Whereas Sections 8, 9, and 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorize municipalities to pass bylaws necessary or desirable for municipal purposes; and

Whereas Sections 434.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, authorize a municipality to establish a system of administrative penalties and to require a person to pay an administrative penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person has failed to comply with a bylaw; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville enacted Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049 to establish a system of administrative penalties; and

Whereas the Council has enacted an Election Sign Bylaw 2026-012 to regulate the placement, maintenance, and removal of election signs within the municipality; and

Whereas the Council has enacted a Salvage Yard Bylaw to regulate the licensing and operation of salvage yards within the municipality; and

Whereas it is necessary and desirable to designate offences under the Election Sign Bylaw 2026-012 and the Salvage Yard Bylaw as administrative penalties and to establish corresponding short form wording and administrative penalty amounts; and

Whereas Council deems it necessary and desirable to amend Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049 to add Schedule "B-17" and Schedule "B-18" to provide such short form wording and administrative penalty amount to ensure clarity, consistency, and effective enforcement; and

Now therefore, be it resolved that Council for the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049 is hereby amended

2. That Schedule "B" of the Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049 is amended by adding Schedule "B-17", attached hereto, respecting short form wording and administrative penalty amounts for offences under the Election Sign Bylaw 2026-012.
3. That Schedule "B" of Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049 is amended by adding Schedule "B-18", attached hereto, respecting short form wording and administrative penalty amounts for offences under the Salvage Yard Bylaw.
4. That Schedule "B-17" and Schedule "B-18" form a part of the Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049.
5. All other provisions of the Administrative Penalty System Bylaw 2025-049, as amended, remain in full force and effect.
6. This bylaw shall come into effect upon approval by the Council, subject to section 284.11.
