

# The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville By-law Number 2025-015

## A by-law to amend By-law 2005-078 being a by-law to regulate traffic in the Town of Orangeville

Whereas the Municipal Act, 2021, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.11 authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws respecting matters within the jurisdiction of highways, including parking and traffic on highways; and

Whereas by resolution 2023-289, on September 11, 2023, Council authorized an increase in the set fine rates for parking and by-law offences; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-078, as amended, with respect to set fine rates;

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council for The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 2005-078, as amended, be further amended by deleting Schedule M and replacing it with Schedule M attached hereto.
