

BY-LAW NUMBER ______<u>57</u> **-2009**

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 22-90 AS AMENDED (Official Plan Review and Zoning By-law Update - OPZ 5/08)

WHEREAS on May 4, 2009, Council held a public meeting with respect to proposals for zoning amendments arising from the review of the Official Plan;

AND WHEREAS on June 8, 2009, following the consideration of public submissions, Council approved the proposals;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT Schedule "A" to By-law 22-90, as amended, is hereby amended in accordance with Schedules "A" to "C" attached hereto.
- 2. THAT Section 5 of By-law 22-90, as amended, be further amended by adding the following thereto:

"5.XX <u>Bicycle Parking Requirements</u>

Bicycle parking spaces are required for the uses listed below in addition to any required parking spaces for motor vehicles:

Multiple dwelling 1 parking space per dwelling unit

Commercial, institutional (excluding schools) 2 parking spaces plus 1 parking

space per 1,000 square metres of

floor area

Industrial 2 parking spaces plus 0.25

parking spaces per 1,000 square

metres of floor area

Elementary and secondary schools 1 per 10 students plus 1 per 35

employees

Post secondary school 1 per 20 students


Each bicycle parking space shall have a minimum length of 1.8 metres and a minimum width of 0.6 metres. A bicycle parking area shall be located on the ground and have direct access and egress to the ground level adjacent to the bicycle parking area."

- 3. THAT Section 11.5(1) of By-law 22-90, as amended, be further amended by deleting the text "/dwelling unit".
- 4. THAT Section 24.173 of By-law 22-90, as amended, be further amended by replacing the text "8.1" with "18.1" and "(R2)" with "Restricted Commercial/Residential (C5)".
- 5. THAT Section 24.174 be deleted.




