Skating Program Definitions

Public Skating - public skating is a program that is open to all ages and to all abilities. It is a supervised program where skaters skate laps around the ice to music of different genres. A pyloned area is available for those learning the basics and skate aids are provided, when available. No sticks or pucks are allowed during this program.

Parent and Preschool - this program is designed for preschool age children to come out and learn to skate in a quiet, relaxed atmosphere. Age-appropriate background music is played and skate aids are available for your use. Helmets must be worn by all preschoolers and for that budding hockey player, a pyloned area is provided to work on shooting as well. No slap shots or raised pucks allowed by parents though!

Adult Recreational Skate - looking for a little exercise at lunch? Come out for a skate if you're over the age of 18 and skate to some background music from the 70's, 80's and 90's. No pucks allowed but you can bring your stick if you require it for balance. Speed skaters are also welcome!

Active 55+ Skate - is designed for the young at heart 55 and over crowd to come out and skate in a very quiet relaxed atmosphere with age appropriate background music playing. No pucks allowed but bring your stick for balance if you need it.

Figure Skating Skills - this ice time is for practicing the fundamentals of figure skating and improving strength and skills. Skater and coaches must pay and receive a wrist band.

Hockey Skills - work on the fundamentals of hockey and improve your skills. No body contact is allowed. Adult/coach is allowed on ice - full equipment is required. Skaters and coaches must pay and receive a wristband.

Adult Shinny and 55+ Shinny - is for those hockey players over the age of 18 looking for a game of pick up hockey at lunch time. This is an unsupervised, non-contact program and is based on a first come first served basis to the first 20 players and 4 goalies.

Youth/Elementary Shinny - this shinny is offered for young people to come out and work on their hockey skills with others in their age bracket. Supervision is provided for the younger age groups. Shinny is a non-contact and non-instructional program. Parents and/or coaches are not allowed on the ice during the kids' or girls' shinny. Each session is open to the first 20 players and 4 goalies.

Shinny Hockey Rules

- Proof of I.D. may be required or requested to meet the age requirements. All participants are to play within their age group.
- The number of participants will be limited to 20 players and 4 goalies.
- Payment will be accepted 30 minutes prior to the event on a first-come first-served basis.
- No adults or coaches allowed on the ice or to conduct a practice session.
- Wrist bands will be used as payment identification.
- Full equipment is mandatory
- No foul language
- No horseplay
- No body contact
- No slap shots
