## Background

The Orangeville Accessibility and Seniors Advisory Committee consists of one member of Council, two to nine public appointments and one representative from the Orangeville Business Improvement Area.

The committee solicits feedback from the community on issues relating to people with disabilities, seniors and other citizens with access issues, and brings to Council matters identified by the Committee as requiring action by the Municipality.

## Analysis

The Orangeville Accessibility and Seniors Advisory Committee participated in various initiatives in 2019 including sponsoring public swims and skates, purchasing extended pool steps for Tony Rose Recreational Centre and funding audio pedestrian signals.

Furthermore, the committee has agreed to incorporate members of the County of Dufferin Accessibility Committee into the Orangeville Accessibility and Seniors Advisory Committee in 2020.

The committee has prepared an annual work plan, which outlines the various projects that will be focused on in 2020.

### **Financial Impact**

For 2019 the committee has spent approximately \$20,000 on special projects, including the sponsored swims and skates, extended pool steps and audio pedestrian signals.

The attached workplan outlines the projected initiatives for 2020, including: Ramp Program Review, Educational Resources, Accessibility Fair, Improvements at Town intersections.
