SAID Day – Students Against Impaired Driving

Whereas, impaired and distracted driving remain a leading cause of serious injury and death on Ontario roads, with young people disproportionately affected; and

Whereas, motor vehicle collisions are one of the leading causes of death among youth and young adults in Canada, and alcohol or drug impairment is a significant contributing factor; and

Whereas, Ontario Students Against Impaired Driving (OSAID) empowers students to take leadership in promoting safe and sober choices, fostering awareness, and strengthening community commitment to road safety; and

Whereas, SAID Day provides an opportunity for students, schools, families, municipalities, and community partners to unite in promoting prevention, education, and responsible decision-making;

Now Therefore, I, Mayor Lisa Post, on behalf of Council, do hereby proclaim **May 14, 2026** as SAID Day – Students Against Impaired Driving in the Town of Orangeville and encourage all residents to support youth leadership and take part in efforts to prevent impaired and distracted driving and save lives.
