



Proclamation

January 2025 - Crime Stoppers Month

Whereas, Crime Stoppers of Simcoe-Dufferin-Muskoka was established on January 12, 1987 and became incorporated as a non-profit charitable organization on February 11, 1987. The program is operated by a volunteer Board of Directors, who oversees all phases of the program; and

Whereas, Crime Stoppers is not a police program nor funded by the provincial or federal government or from police agencies. The program is operated solely with monies generously donated from the private sector, businesses or raised through fundraising efforts of the volunteer Board of Directors and committee volunteers; and

Whereas, Crime Stoppers is a program that benefits everyone in the community and in 2005 Crime Stoppers International was recognized by the United Nations as a global force in the fight against crime and terrorism; and

Whereas, Crime Stoppers' mandate is to assist the police in solving crimes thereby making our communities and schools safer. Through the media, the public is encouraged to call a province wide toll-free number 1-800-222-8477 with any information about a crime that has occurred or is about to occur. If the information provided solves or prevents a crime, the anonymous caller is eligible for a cash reward; and

Whereas, Anonymous calls to Crime Stoppers of Simcoe-Dufferin-Muskoka have assisted police and other investigative agencies in making 5,351 arrests, recovering stolen property valued at over \$13.6 million and seizing over \$84 million in illegal drugs. For this information, Crime Stoppers has approved \$452,772 in cash rewards and received over 77,000 tips.

Now Therefore, I, Mayor Lisa Post, on behalf of Council, do hereby proclaim January, 2026 as "Crime Stoppers Month" in the Town of Orangeville.
