Parking on municipal streets is prohibited from 2-7 a.m.

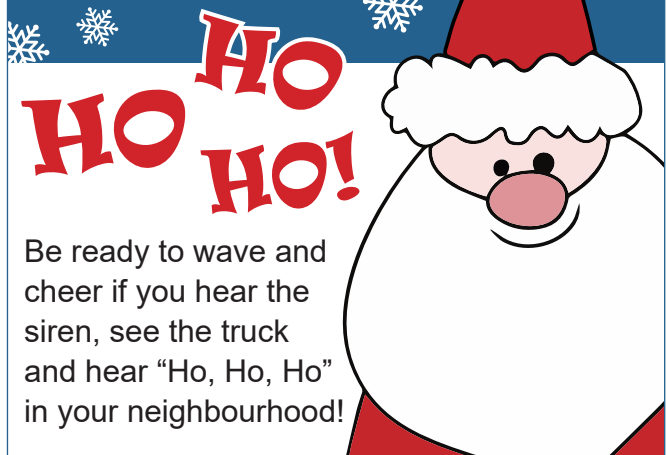
Overnight winter parking is permitted only at Rotary Park and Fendley Park.
