# Election Workers

The Town of Orangeville is seeking election workers to facilitate voting in the 2022 Municipal Election.

A detailed list of the required positions and rates can be found on our elections portal at [elections.orangeville.ca](http://elections.orangeville.ca)

### Applicants must be:

- Eligible to work in Canada
- Available to attend a training session scheduled between September 19 and September 26, 2022.
- Available to work extended hours on Election Day – Monday October 24, 2022.

Remuneration for these positions range from \$125 - \$400 for Advance Voting Days and Election Day. In addition to performing assigned positions, Election Officials will be required to attend 1 training session (the week of September 19 or September 26, 2022), which will be 2-3 hours in length depending on the position.

All interested applicants must complete the Election Worker Application Form from our elections portal at [elections.orangeville.ca](http://elections.orangeville.ca), under the Voters tab.

Application forms will be received in person or online until 4:30 p.m. on July 15, 2022.

**Senior Instructor/Guard**  
(Two part-time positions - 24 hours/week)

The Community Services Department has two part-time opportunities available for the position of Senior Instructor/Guard. This position provides instruction in aquatic programs and lifesaving services in accordance with the standards of the Lifesaving Society and other regulatory agencies and maintain pool facilities to prescribed standards and conditions. Successful candidates must have open availability for weekdays, evenings, and weekend shifts with a rotating schedule.

### Job Duties:

- Acting as the Head Instructor/Guard during swimming lessons and programs; completing administrative tasks such as facility/shift checks, accident reports, overseeing guarding rotations, water testing, completing logbooks and lesson plans; and assisting the full-time staff as required.
- Providing customer service to families during swimming lesson in a variety of program levels; completing lesson plans, participant report cards and any other required program documentation.
- Performing guarding duties in accordance with legislation, policies, standards, and procedures; delivering advanced aquatic courses for staff and public; completing opening and closing procedures for the pool facility and change rooms as required.
- Other duties as assigned.

### Qualifications:

- Minimum qualifications include current enrolment in a secondary school
- Completion of secondary education is an asset
- Post-secondary education in Recreation Studies or a related field is an asset
- Minimum of one (1) year of previous experience as swim instructor and lifeguard
- Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard – Pool
- Lifesaving/or Red Cross Standard First Aid with CPR "C"
- Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor
- Lifesaving Society Lifesaving Instructor
- Lifesaving Society Emergency First Aid Instructor
- Lifesaving Society Aquatic Supervisor Training (AST)
- Bronze Examiner, National Lifeguard Instructor, Standard First Aid Instructor, Lifesaving Society Instructor Trainer, or Aqua fitness certifications would all be considered assets
- Strong oral and written communications skills with the ability to follow and provide clear direction and be assertive in a fair, consistent manner
- Strong problem solving, decision making and interpersonal relations skills

**Successful candidates will be required to complete a background check, including but not limited to a Vulnerable Sector Check, in accordance with the duties of this position.**
