Fireworks Salet

If you choose to have family fireworks, here are some things to remember:

- Review the Town of Orangeville Fireworks Bylaw – check it out online.
- Appoint a responsible person to be in charge. Only adults who are aware of the hazards and safety precautions should handle and discharge fireworks.
- Carefully read and follow the manufacturers labeled directions on fireworks packaging.
- Always keep a water hose or pail of water close by when discharging fireworks.
- Discharge fireworks well away from combustible materials like buildings, trees and dry grass.

Keep onlookers a safe distance away, upwind from the area where fireworks are discharged.

DID YOU KNOW?

To minimize the risk of fire and burn injury, the fire service does not recommend family fireworks or informal

neighbourhood display Your safety is our top priority!

Light only one firework at a time and only when they are on the ground. Never try to light a firework in your hand or re-light dud fireworks. For dud fireworks, it is best to wait 30 minutes and soak them in a bucket of water and dispose in a metal container.

Keep sparklers away from children. Sparklers burn extremely hot and can ignite clothing and result in severe burns. As the sparkler wires remain hot after burnout, place them in water to avoid injury.

Be a good neighbour and always consider the safety and well-being of your neighbours as you celebrate!
