Junior Help Desk Student

Temporary contract: May - September 2022

The Town has a student job opportunity available, for the position of Junior Help Desk Student. This position shall start as soon as possible and will end in September. The Junior Help Desk Student will offer support and technical assistance to internal customers who use software, hardware, or other computer systems and need help completing tasks or troubleshooting problems through diagnostic tests and remote access to their computers. This position is thirty-five (35) hours per week.

Job Duties:

- Responding to queries via chat, email, or phone; serving as the first point of contact for customers seeking technical assistance; writing, editing, and revising training manuals for new and updated software and hardware; providing technical assistance for questions and problems; diagnosing system errors and other issues; and following up with customers to ensure full resolution of issues.
- Installing or changing software to fix issues; remotely accessing hardware or software for clients to make changes and fix problems; resolving problems with networks and other computer systems; and assisting users in security awareness, training for mobile, workstation and online accounts.
- Helping manage end user accounts for subscription systems; maintaining software and hardware assets through internal systems; remediating systems affected as required; and escalating to second tier support internally or externally to find solutions.

Qualifications:

- Working towards a diploma or degree in Information Technology, or a related course of study.
- Strong knowledge of Microsoft Client Operating Systems (Windows 10,11).
- Microsoft Office skills, knowledge of mobile devices, PC hardware skills, and familiarity with both PC and Mac hardware and software.

Please note:

- To be eligible for this job, students must be enrolled in full-time post-secondary education. Students may be asked to provide proof of enrolment.
- Virtual interview formats are available for this position.
- All Town student positions are subject to budget and grant approval, and thus may be subject to change.


