Description of the Subject Land:

The lands subject to these applications are comprised of two parcels located on the south side of Broadway, east of Riddell Road. The subject lands are legally described as Part of Lot 5 Concession C, and Part of Lot 5 Concession C Parts 1 and 2 on Registered Plan 7R-5321 and are municipally known as 670 & 690 Broadway. The parcels have a combined lot area of approximately 1.107 hectares (2.735 acres), with approximately

173 metres (567.59 feet) of frontage along Broadway. The subject lands currently contain 2 single detached dwellings. A location map of the subject lands is attached.


Purpose and Effect of the Application:

Description of the Subject Land:

The lands subject to these applications are located on the east side of Mill Street, between Mary Street and Wellington Street. The subject lands are legally described as Lot 23, Block 7 on Registered Plan 138, and are municipally known as 99 Mill Street. The subject lands have a lot area of approximately 0.063 hectares (0.157 acres), with approximately 15.6 metres (51.3 feet) of frontage along Mill Street. The subject lands are presently developed with a two-storey building. A location map of the subject lands is attached.

Purpose and Effect of the Applications:

The purpose and effect of the applications is to convert the existing building from a mixed-use commercial and residential

building, to a multiple-residential building containing four (4) units. Three (3) parking spaces are currently provided within the driveway at the rear of the property, accessed by Peavoy Lane.

The Official Plan Amendment proposes to redesignate the subject lands from "Neighbourhood Commercial" to "Residential" with a "Low Density Multiple" overlay to permit a multiple-residential building. The Zoning By-law Amendment proposes to rezone the subject lands from "Neighbourhood Commercial" (C2 Zone) to "Multiple Residential Medium Density" (RM1 Zone).
